C.E.M. CERTIFICATE

This certificate must be submitted online before arrival of the Lot at Park Paddocks or at the duplicate or outside standing.

The Vendor or his/her Agent is solely responsible for the accuracy of this certificate.

To be completed by a Veterinary Surgeon:

Two clitoral swabs (fossa and sinuses) should be taken at least 7 days apart. One set of swabs should be dated **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE SALE (i.e. from June 6th onwards)**. Swabs must be submitted to a Laboratory approved by the Horserace Betting Levy Board (HBLB) in the United Kingdom or to National Approved Laboratories in all other countries and be cultured under both aerobic and microaerophilic conditions or tested by PCR.

On the 17th June 2021 and 25th June 2021 (Dates, please see above) swabs were obtained

from the **CLITORIS (FOSSA AND SINUSES)** of the filly LATE MORNING (IRE) (Name) and submitted for

bacteriological examination for C.E.M. at the **NEWMARKET EQUINE HOSPITAL** Laboratory and cultured under both aerobic and microaerophilic conditions or tested by PCR.

The results were negative. Neither *Klebsiella pneumoniae* nor *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* were isolated.
