## EQUINE VIRAL ARTERITIS (EVA) SEROLOGY REPORT

A blood sample identified as collected from the above horse, by the above veterinary surgeon, was submitted for Equine Viral Arteritis Antibody (Virus Neutralisation) test.

The results are:

**Negative**

EVA is a notifiable disease under the EVA Order 1995:

If disease is suspected in a stallion, either on the basis of clinical signs or blood/semen testing, this must be notified to the APHA for further investigation.

If disease is suspected in a mare, on the basis of clinical signs or blood testing, then this must be notified to the APHA if the mare has been mated or artificially inseminated within the past 14 days.
